

**Seven Lakes West Landowners Association  
Board of Directors Special Session  
Friday, July 24, 2009

**Call to order:**

Vice president John Hoffmann called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.  
Directors present: Ed Silberhorn, John Hoffmann, Mick Herdrich, Ed Tuton, Karen Milligan, and Adam Wimberly. Directors absent: John Goodman, Ron Shepard, and Kathy Kirst. A quorum was established.

**Revisions of Rules and Regulations:**

The purpose of the meeting was to review numerous recommendations made by various committees and directors in order to update and clarify community rules and regulations. The secretary agreed to create a preamble explaining the need for community rules, and the need for the proposed revisions. The revision requires a notice in bold print stating that **“THIS DOCUMENT REGULATES AND PROHIBITS THE DISPLAY OF POLITICAL SIGNS.”**

Director Silberhorn commented that instituting the updated rules would be a “material issue under the by-laws, and will require two readings and public comment prior to passage.

Mick Herdrich made, and Karen Milligan seconded, a motion to reinstate rule 2.2.4, which prohibits vehicles towing trailers from entering the east gate. The motion was approved by a vote of 6-0.

After review and agreement upon all proposed changes in chapters one through eight, Karen Milligan made, and Mick Herdrich seconded a motion to adjourn. Without objection, the meeting adjourned at 4:20 p.m.
